



EBA Scholarship Information

The Bachelor of Arts Program in Economics (EBA) has established an “Undergraduate Scholarship Program for Students” to provide financial assistance to students who wish to pursue their studies at our EBA Program.

Scholarship application is open for the regular admission rounds (Early Admission & Admission) as well as the international admission rounds (Round 1 & Round 2). Up to **15 EBA scholarships** are granted each batch:

- Up to **5 full scholarships** (equivalent to 10 partial scholarships) for Thai students.
- Up to **5 full scholarships** (equivalent to 10 partial scholarships) for non-Thai students.
- **5 full scholarships for the first academic year** for the **highest ranking** applicants admitted to the EBA program from the Early Admission round.

Applicants will be eligible for the scholarship award consideration provided that he/she has no record of misconduct and meets the three academic criteria as prescribed below:

Applicant’s minimum academic requirements

No.	Requirements
1	GPAX \geq 3.50
2	English proficiency test scores 2.1 IELTS \geq 7.0 or 2.2 TOEFL (Internet based) \geq 94 or 2.3 SAT (Evidence-Based Reading & Writing) \geq 550 or 2.4 ACT (English & Reading) \geq 43 or 2.5 Duolingo English Test \geq 130 or 2.6 CU-TEP \geq 94 or 2.7 CU-AAT (Verbal) \geq 500
3	Math proficiency test scores 3.1 SAT (Math) \geq 770 or 3.2 ACT (Math) \geq 35 or 3.3 A-Level Math Grade = A* or 3.4 IB Math (Higher Level) = 7 or 3.5 CU-AAT (Math) \geq 720

Notes:

1. Scholarships are allocated on a competitive basis. The award of all scholarships is final and at the discretion of the EBA Committee. The minimum academic requirement, where applicable, serve only as an eligibility criteria.
2. The scholarship will be renewed annually and may be stopped if the students have poor academic records or bad behaviors.
