

EBA Scholarship Information

The Bachelor of Arts Program in Economics (EBA) offers an "Undergraduate Scholarship Program for Students" to provide financial assistance to students who wish to pursue their studies at our EBA Program.

Scholarships are available for those applying during the regular admission rounds (Early Admission & Admission) as well as the international admission rounds (Round 1 & Round 2).

The eligibility requirements for scholarship applicants are (1) having no record of misconduct and (2) meeting the following minimum academic criteria:

- 1. Scholarships are allocated on a competitive basis. The granting of scholarships is at the discretion of the EBA Committee whose decisions are final. The minimum academic requirements, where applicable, serve only as eligibility criteria.
- 2. Scholarships will be renewed annually and may be discontinued if the students have poor academic performance or exhibit bad behavior.
